



ALLIANCE ALL STAR TEAM TRYOUT INFORMATION

All Star teams are the secondary season or sometimes referred to as “tournament season” for the just concluded registered Fall season players in the U10 through U19 divisions of AYSO. The season begins in December and runs through April – possibly longer. This is a player selection process. The cost commitment varies from team to team, but the average is \$300* per player.

*\$200 fee is partially tax deductible which covers cost of uniforms and registration – due December 10. \$100 or more recommended through tax deductible donations or team fundraisers.

TO QUALIFY FOR THE ALLIANCE ALL STAR TEAM:

PLAYER MUST:

- Have played in at least half of the just concluded (2011) core season AYSO
- Be at least 8 years of age by July 31, 2011
- No outstanding fees owed to the region
- Attend a maximum of 3 practices a week
- Be on time and prepared for practices – water, shin guards and a ball
- Show respect to team, coaches, other players and referees
- Be able to play Saturday and Sunday tournaments
- Be willing to help with fundraising and sponsorship efforts
- Have the parental or guardian support needed for traveling to tournaments
- Be willing to support Region 688’s Crossroads Cup on February 10-12, 2012

PARENT MUST:

- Make sure your player is prepared for practices – water, shin guards and a ball
- Show respect to your player, other players, coaches and referees
- Let the coach’s coach. Players play. Referees ref.
- Be able to get your player to Saturday and Sunday tournaments.
- Be willing to help with the team’s fundraising and sponsorship efforts
- Be willing to work at Region 688’s Crossroads Cup on February 10-12, 2012
- Be willing to volunteer where needed
- Be in a financial position to support your child as an all star team player
